We are all here to have a good weekend and enjoy ourselves, but we do have a few very straight forward rules for your and everyone else's safety. As always, it's your show, please treat it with the respect and care you have given it over the years. Most of what follows is common sense, but it has to be said;

Event Rules/Information

Access

Access is through Gate 1 (as sign posted)

Disabled access is through Gate 2 (sign posted and also where the museum entrance is)

First Aid/Welfare

The First Aid station will be situated at the VBOA gazebo, near the main arena and will be highlighted on any maps.

Water

4 Taps will be available, 1 at the showers, two near the entrance gate and 1 opposite the VX4/90 & FD stand.

Speed Limit

There is a 5mph onsite speed limit during the event (with the exception of the motorsport area). Car movement is permitted between 0700 and 2100, any vehicles found to be moving outside of these times will be asked to park up and left until 7am.

NO DRUG/DRINKING AND DRIVING ON SITE: This also covers no driving with people hanging out of various vehicle orifices.

Wheel Spins/Donuts/any other car ballet is NOT permitted at all!!!!!!

Anyone caught/seen/filmed doing it will be ejected from the show there and a lifetime ban from VBOA events.

We are at an airfield, any damage to the grass will result in charges to repair it.

There is the motorsport area to exercise your desires of this nature, please use it

When driving to/from the event, you will be passing through villages, please stick to the speed limits and be courteous to everyone.

No Drones

BBQ's

BBQS SHALL be purpose built and raised OFF the ground (i.e. no placing a disposable BBQ directly on the grass, use a paving slab or raise it off the ground properly). Security and VBOA officials will be conducting regular patrols to ensure compliance.

Children/Under 16's

Parents and guardians must supervise children at all times.

In the event of a child being lost, the muster point will be situated at the VBOA gazebo, near the main arena and will be highlighted on any maps.

If you have an activities wristband for your child (if not, why not?) we suggest you write your contact number and if applicable, car club on there as a precaution.

Camping/Caravanning

Please ensure that emergency access is possible to all tents/caravans with at least 3M between tents and 6M between caravans.

The following provisions have been made for campers' welfare:

- An emergency point of contact is available with the onsite security officer (Night Shift)
- A means of raising the alarm and fire-fighting equipment
- There is a supply of drinking water available
- There are public toilets open and available for use during the night

While there generators are permitted, we would kindly ask that you only run them during sociable hours, and always away from yours and other people's tents, we have electric hook-ups near the museum if you wish to have permanent power.

Rubbish/Waste

There will be bins located around the site for simple day to day waste, with them being emptied into a large skip that as frequently as possible. Your club stand is your responsibility to keep tidy, each club will be issued with a few bin bags to help with this.

HOT ASHES to be placed in the Metal bins provided. **NONE** to be put in the other bins or the skip(s). Note: some coals etc can be hot enough to burn after 6+hours from lighting.

Noise

We are here for a good time, but please respect those who wish to sleep. The noise aside from Hanger 1 (where the bar/music/bands are) should be kept to a sociable/polite level after 2300.

Local Amenities

There is an onsite bar and restaurant

A 15Min walk (or few minute Drive) to the South West is the Horseshoe Pub, good food.

Supermarkets, there is the Tescos and Lidl in Northampton (that you may have used when at Billing) NN3 8JZ. There is also a Sainsbury's (NN8 3GZ) and Morrisons in Wellingborough. Both sets of shops are approx. 10-15mins drive away.
